From Der Hayr's Desk

Mirroring God's Generosity

St. John Chrysostom (347 -407 CE) was one of the most powerful and outspoken critics on the subject of wealth and poverty. The plight of the poor and the apathy towards them was so troubling to John that he gave homilies on the subject of *Wealth and Poverty* on seven separate occasions within a short span of time. He also wrote a treatise on *Almsgiving and Repentance*.

John's purpose was to focus Christians on the importance of the spiritual wealth of the soul, rather than the physical attachments to worldly wealth. The connection between repentance and almsgiving was strongly emphasized in the early Church. Almsgiving, along with prayer, fasting and even mourning, were all essential elements of repentance which was foundational to the Christian faith. According to St John, almsgiving was the way that the believer purified the intentions of his heart in preparation for true repentance. Therefore, it is understandable why almsgiving, eternal rewards and punishment are interwoven throughout John's writings on the subject as the main theme. The goal is to prompt Christians to become faithful stewards through the Godly attribute of generosity by becoming God's extended arms to the poor.

Almsgiving, as an act mirroring God's generosity, is a theme that is stressed throughout the Old and New Testaments. It represents the greatest

form of generosity – giving without expecting anything in return. For John Chrysostom, it is impossible to be a Christian and at the same time have no concern for the poor. He encourages a spirit of generosity, mirroring the generosity of God, simply because of the need and without judgment of character or worthiness, because all are in need of mercy.

John even presents almsgiving as an intercessor before the Throne of God on Judgment Day. He writes: "Give to the poor, so that even if you keep silent almsgiving will take your side and plead on your behalf." In the Book of Acts we read about a centurion in the Italian Regiment named Cornelius to whom the angel said: "Your prayers and gifts (alms) to the poor have come up as a memorial offering before God" (Acts 10:4). It is clear from the scriptures that compassion towards the poor is most pleasing to God and is an act mirroring God's generosity towards man.

May our generosity towards God's work and each other be a pleasing offering in the sight of God.
